- EVENT TIME:** 8:00 am Shotgun
- Please check-in 30 minutes prior to tee time or an alternate will be allowed to play in your place, and entry fee may be forfeited.
- EVENT FORMAT:** This is an 18-Hole, Tournament Tee, Shamle Event
- MOMC Members are encouraged to bring a guests to this event
 - 2-man teams, pick your own partner
 - Handicaps will be calculated based on 90 % of each player's course handicap
 - In a shamle, each member of the team hits a tee shot and one of these shots is selected. From the selected tee shot, each team member then plays out the hole with their own ball for their own individual score
 - Individual players net scores will be converted to points as follows:

Double Bogey = -2	Bogey = -1	Par = 0 points
Birdie = 1	Eagle = 3	Double Eagle = 4 points
 - Individual points will be added together for a team score per hole
 - Must use at least 3 tee shots from each team member
 - Players may place their ball within one club length of the selected tee shot, no nearer the hole. The placed ball must remain in like conditions (hazard, fairway, rough, etc...)
 - If the selected tee shot comes to rest on the green, the placed ball must be played from as close as possible to selected tee shot, no nearer the hole
 - Individual nearies on all par 3's
- NOTES:**
- USGA rules will govern all play except where modified by this format
 - Local rules sheets, skins, and/or other games available at registration table
 - Number of places/payouts determined by the number of entrants
 - The handicap committee will review & may adjust all handicaps prior to event

Tournament Rules

EVENT FORMAT: 2-man, 18-Hole, Shamble Tournament

- EVENT RULES:**
- In a shamble event, all team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
 - The other team members pick up their balls and place them within **one club length (no nearer the hole)** of the marked spot.
 - If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
 - From the selected tee shot, each team member then plays out the hole with their own ball for their own individual score
 - If the selected tee shot comes to rest on the green, the placed ball must be played from **as close as possible to the marked spot (no closer to the hole)**.
 - The team should record both players' **gross scores** per hole on the official score card.
 - Teams should turn in completed, signed, and attested scorecards to the scoring area within **15 minutes** of completing the round.
 - Individual players net scores will be converted to points as follows:
Double Bogey = -2 Bogey = -1 Par = 0 Birdie = 1 Eagle = 3 Double Eagle = 4
 - Individual points will be added together for a team score per hole

TEEING GROUNDS: All play shall be from the **Tournament** Tees

TEE SHOTS: Each player's tee shot must be used at least **three** times during the 18-hole competition.

ONE BALL RULE The one ball rule is **NOT** in effect for this event.

- LOCAL ETIQUETTE:**
- **Wait** to play until the players in front of you are out of range
 - **Replace** your divots, or fill with sand/seed mix in the fairways
 - **Smooth** all marks made in sand hazards, leaving the rakes **in** the hazards
 - **Keep** power carts away from all tee boxes, hazards, and greens
 - **Fix** ball marks on the greens
 - **Flatten** spike marks **after** you have puttied out
 - **Leave** the putting green as soon as you have holed out
